Hinsdale Central will return six of its seven top scorers from last season and will have 62% of their offense from last year back for the 2024-25 campaign.

Vince Buzelis, is a returning All-West Suburban Conference selection. Buzelis, who has committed to the University of South Dakota, led the Red Devils in rebounding in 27 of their 31 games last year. Vince is the younger brother of Chicago Bulls first-round draft choice, and Hinsdale Central alumnus, Matas Buzelis.

Six-foot, eight-inch Tyler Thick returns for his third season on the varsity. Dillon Dell established the Hinsdale Central Holiday Classic single game three-point shooting record last year, going six-for-six from outside the arc against Schaumburg. Seniors Eric Kozys, Michael Howell and Dillon Orozco all received starting assignments from last year's varsity club. The Red Devils should also excel in team depth, as the Hinsdale Central sophomore teams have won the West Suburban Conference Silver title the last three seasons.

Hinsdale Central will open play at the Hoops for Healing Tournament during Thanksgiving Week, with games being played this year at both Oswego High School and Oswego East High School.

The Red Devils will host their own Holiday Classic over the Christmas break; and will play in the Shot Clock Shootout at Sandburg High School; the West Suburban Conference / Mid Suburban League Showdown at Buffalo Grove High School; the Martin Luther King Shootout at Fenwick High School; and compete in the Batavia Night of Hoops.

In addition to playing in the West Suburban Conference Silver Division, the Red Devils have non-conference home games against Downers South, Wheaton Academy, Fenwick and Prospect; and will travel to St. Patrick, Hinsdale South and Bartlett.

ASSISTANT COACH JOE SPAGNOLO









HINSDALE HOOP ALUMNI FAST FACTS

- Matas Buzelis was selected with the eleventh overall pick of the 2024 NBA Draft by the Chicago Bulls. Matas only played at Hinsdale Central during his freshman year, before playing at Brewster Academy in New Hampshire, Sunrise Christian Academy in Kansas, and the NBA G-League.
- Brian Wardle became the third all-time leading scorer for Marquette University. Brian is currently the head basketball coach at Bradley University.
- Bob Haarlow was an All-State athlete in both basketball and football. Bob was starter on the Tigers basketball team at Princeton University, whose team advanced to the 1965 NCAA Final Four.
- Marty Riessen was Hinsdale Central basketball MVP in 1959 and 1960. He won four straight IHSA tennis singles state championships, before playing both sports at Northwestern. Riessen would later win nine grand slam championships in tennis, including two Wimbledon mixed doubles titles.
- Joe Nehls was the first Hinsdale Central basketball player inducted into the Illinois Basketball Museum Hall of Fame. He won multiple All-Conference awards in the Pac-10 while playing for the University of Arizona.
- At Furman University, Matt Rafferty led his team in scoring and set the all-time school record for steals. In his four years with the Paladins, he would win more games than any other player in the history of the program.
- Jim Flynn still holds the school record for points in a game with his 50-point performance back in 1972.
